Call for Applications for Guest Lectureships at the Heidelberg University of Education and the Participating Partner Universities

Ladies and Gentlemen, dear colleagues,

Within the framework of the ProMobil^{GS} project, funds are provided for guest lectureships in cooperation with participating partner universities for the period 01.01.22 - 31.12.24. The guest lectureships are intended to strengthen the bilateral relations between the Heidelberg University of Education and the participating partner universities through teaching and academic cooperation, and to serve the formation of networks for the internationalisation of teacher training. If desired, the CITE will be happy to assist in arranging contacts. The guest lectureships are aimed at lecturers and students at the participating partner universities. The lectureships consider didactic and contrastive aspects. In this way they provide professional support for the ProMobil^{GS} project.

According to the approved application, funds are available for guest lectureships at and from our partner universities. According to the planning, one lectureship per calendar year can be realised in both directions per partner university.

You can now offer a guest lectureship at a partner university and invite colleagues for a guest lectureship in Heidelberg. As project leader, I ask you to use the attached form (see Appendix 1 "ProMobiLGS Guest Lectureship Application") to apply for funding.

1. Planning

According to the approved application, the following guest lectureships are planned for the entire duration of the project.

The dates are to be understood as suggestions and can be handled flexibly.

2. Formats

A. Courses:

- Lecture, seminar, tutorial, workshop, block seminar, etc. (Opportunity for team teaching)

Call for Applications Guest Lectures

- University public lecture (at Heidelberg University of Education: if applicable, crediting to the “Global Citizen” certificate)

B. Work meetings

- Expert exchange
- Development of joint projects
- Planning of publications
- Planning and coordination of further measures
- Comparison of study contents/common standards, if applicable

3. Time scope

Per day: at least one course (ca. 90 minutes)

4. Financing

Financing is provided through project funds.

4.1 Teaching staff of Heidelberg University of Education

- Application for funding and business trip application via project manager Henrike Schön to the dean and HR department
- A1 application, if applicable
- Settlement after completion of the lectureship via the HR department according to the Landesreisekostengesetz (state travel cost law) under presentation of the original receipts. Reimbursed are travel costs for rail travel in 2nd class or flight costs from a distance of more than 1,000 km in economy class. Accommodation costs are reimbursed according to the Landesreisekostengesetz (LRKG). In justified exceptional cases, these can be exceeded, but only up to the rates specified by the DAAD. Daily allowances are calculated according to the Landesreisekostengesetz.
