

Special Needs: ENG 05M – Advanced Literary/Cultural Studies and Action Research – Secondary Level

Classes:

- Literary Studies
- Cultural Studies
- Empirical Research/Action Research - **Requirements:** You have to bring another class (theoretical background) for your empirical research design. You have two options:
 1. You can show the feedback sheet of a linguistics or TEFL class from your final BA module
 2. You can do a cultural studies or literary studies class parallel in this module, and then show the feedback sheet at the end of the semester

Exam: Paper - Empirical research design

Special Needs: ENG 05M – Advanced Literary/Cultural Studies and Action Research

Three classes – you have to take:

- Action Research / Introduction to Empirical Research Linguistics and
- Cultural Studies and
- Literary Studies

Secondary: ENG 12 – *Integration of basic disciplines and teaching English as a Foreign Language I*

Classes:

- 1 lecture at the University of Heidelberg (Literature, Cultural Studies or Linguistics)

Note: In this class you need to meet the required workload which will include some form of written exam. Please provide a confirmation from the university lecturer that you have attended the course with your ENG12 exam paper.

- 2 classes at the PH in two of the four fields (TEFL, Cultural Studies, Linguistics, Literary Studies)

Exam: Academic paper (Cultural Studies, Literary Studies, Linguistics) in one of the classes at the PH HD

Secondary: ENG 13 – *Integration of basic disciplines and teaching English as a Foreign Language II*

Classes:

- 1 content class at the University of Heidelberg (Cultural Studies, Linguistics or Literary Studies)

Note: In this class you need to meet the required workload which will include some form of written exam. Please provide a confirmation from the university lecturer that you have attended the course with your ENG13 exam paper.

- 2 classes at the PH HD

→ one TEFL class

→ one content class (Cultural Studies, Linguistics or Literary Studies).

Note: You cannot take the same area you took at the U of Heidelberg (E.g. if the class taken at the U of Heidelberg was a Cultural Studies class, you need to take a Linguistics or Literary Studies class at the PH HD).

Exam: Academic Paper (TEFL) in one of the classes at the PH HD

Secondary: ISPM – Begleitveranstaltung zum ISP

During your ISP you take the Methodology class.

Note: This class starts as a block during the term break before the ISP starts!

Secondary: MAM – Colloquium

Is mandatory
