DAAD programme STIBET I, funded by the Federal Foreign Office of the German government

The International Office of the Heidelberg University of Education grants scholarships for Ukrainian academics who have fled their country of origin.

Scholarship amount: 500 - max. 2,000 EUR / month

Duration: August - December 2023

Application deadline: 31 May 2023

Eligible for application are Ukrainian academics who have been refugees and are staying at Heidelberg University of Education in an academic context at the time of application until the end of the funding period for which the application has been submitted.

Application:

The application must be submitted as a hard copy addressed to the director of the International Office at Heidelberg University of Education.

The application must include the following documents:

- Informal letter of application (max. 1 page) with the following information
 - period of funding applied for
 - academic project to be carried out within the funding period applied for
 - address in Germany
 - bank account in Germany
- Letter of recommendation from a supervising university professor at Heidelberg University of Education
- A statement that the applicant does not already have a sponsorship approval from the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation's Philipp Schwartz Initiative, has not submitted an application therein, or does not intend to do so (avoidance of double sponsorship).
- Passport copy

The decision on funding is made in accordance with the DAAD guidelines.
